American Opportunity Credit

The purpose of this tax credit is to make college more affordable by directly reducing the amount of money a person owes in taxes. The maximum American Opportunity Tax Credit for the 2009 tax year is \$2,500 in each of a student's first four years of college.

Lifetime Learning Credit

Unlike the American Opportunity Credit, which can be claimed only during the first 4 years, the Lifetime Learning Credit can be used for qualifying courses at the undergraduate, graduate or professional level. The credit is 20% of the first \$10,000 (up to \$2,000 per return) for eligible students.
