



Summer Accelerator 2017 Scholarship Application

Application must be submitted to the Financial Aid office by May 19, 2017

Summary of program: The CCRI Summer Accelerator is a summer scholarship program designed to support current students in continuing their education and making faster progress toward degree attainment. The program will cover tuition, fees and a book allowance for students to take one or two courses during Summer Session 1. Funds will be awarded on a rolling, first-come, first-awarded basis for eligible students. CCRI expects to award a minimum of 200 Summer Accelerator Scholarships.

To be considered, a student must:

- Be a resident of Rhode Island
- Be currently enrolled in a degree program at CCRI and enrolled in classes this spring
- Be maintaining Satisfactory Academic Progress
- Have demonstrated initial progress toward a degree (evidenced by 12+ credits earned to date)
- Be enrolled in Summer Session 1 (funds not available for Summer Session 2)
- Meet one of the following criteria:
 - Plan to attend CCRI in the fall
 - Plan to graduate from CCRI this summer
- Have completed a 2016-2017 FAFSA that demonstrates financial need
- Not be enrolled in a health science program (health science students are already considered for CCRI institutional funding)
