### How long is the course?

- Level courses: 50 hours (3 months)
- Advanced classes: 40 hours (2.5 months)
- Conversation classes: 24 hours (2 months).

# STEP 1: Scan the QR code.



#### **NFW STUDENT**

- 1. Select "Create New Profile."
- 2. Follow steps below to register.

#### **RETURNING STUDENT**

- 1. Sign In.
- 2. Select Browse, Adult Education, English Language Studies.
- 3. Select your class and register
- 4. During the week before the course start date, you will receive an email with all course details (Classroom Number or Zoom Link, Book, Instructor)

# STEP 2: Register (NEW STUDENT)

## If you are a NEW STUDENT you have two options:

- Register directly for Level 1 (basic) <u>if you never have taken English classes</u> before.
- <u>OR</u> Register for a level assessment first (to determine if you are ready to begin a higher level).

#### Register for Level 1 (basic)

#### Once you are logged in your account, select:

- Browse
- Adult Education
- ELS English Language Studies
- 1. Select your preferred Level 1 class. Classes are available Online, Lincoln campus, or Providence campus.
- 2. Add to cart, view cart, and finalize the payment (checkout)\*.
- 3. You will receive an email confirmation.
- 4. During the week before the course start date, you will receive an email with all course details & instructions: book, instructor, and room number.

## Register for a Level Assessment

Once you are logged in your account, select:

- Browse
- Adult Education
- ELS Level Assessment
- 1. Select a date/time to complete the assessment. Assessments are completed Online.
- 2. Add to cart, view cart, and finalize the payment (checkout).
- 3. You will receive an email confirmation.
- 4. The day before the test date, you will receive an email with all test details and instructions.
