Answers for Exercise #3: Outlining an Essay By Dr. Karen Petit

The following sentences need to be described and re-arranged into a logical essay structure. For each sentence, on the line furthest to the left, write **TS** for the thesis statement, **SP** for a supporting point, **D** for details, and **C** for the concluding sentence. Then add numbers to show which sentence should be first, which sentence should be second, etc. Note: more details (besides the ones included here) will be needed in each of the body paragraphs for a more effective essay.
