# Opticianry Program Estimated Program Costs

#### **General Education Requirements**

The Opticianry program is a two-year distance learning program. Prerequisite courses are required before acceptance into the program. The total program cost may vary for students who choose a different option for completing the General Education courses.

The costs for the General Education courses are integrated with the program costs by semester. The estimated cost of textbooks for the General Education courses is distributed equally between the last four semesters of the program.
