The Report on Athletic Program Participation Rates and Financial Support Data

The Community College of Rhode Island did not participate in any intercollegiate sports competition during the reporting period beginning July 15, 2020 and ending June 30, 2021 due to COVID-19 restrictions. There were no student-athletes during the reporting period. Expenses for intercollegiate athletics for the reporting period were \$552.00 for men’s baseball caps. No recruiting expenses were incurred.

Full time enrollment for the academic year 2020-2021 was 6,867 (unduplicated). The gender breakdown is listed below.
