Sick Bank...

Raise Update...

As the membership knows, the College didn't implement our negotiated 2.5% wage increase on July 1, 2020. Therefore, NEARI/CCRIPSA filed an Unfair Labor Practice (ULP) with the RI State Labor Relations Board for not bargaining in good faith. In addition, we filed with the American Arbitration Association for the failure to implement the negotiated wage increase.



The ULP hearing was held in December, we were represented by NEARI legal counsel, Jennifer Azevedo, Esq., with testimony given by PSA President Jude Tomasino and NEARI representative Crystal Bergantine. The College was represented by Michael Chittick, Esq., with testimony from AVP Alix Ogden and Ann Marie Coleman, Director of Labor Relations.

The College made a motion to defer the ULP due to our arbitration filing, we objected to their request. The hearing was held and each side had to present their support for or against the motion by the end of December.

On January 13, 2021, the Labor Relations Board denied the motion/request made by CCRI to defer the ULP decision. Therefore, final briefs are due by the end of the month. NEARI is preparing our final document.

Currently, the arbitration hearing is scheduled for early February. As more information is available it will be shared with the membership.
