 - Unsure about new CRM and whether it would create problems or opportunities
 - Tessier agreed to submit IT ticket to ask where questions live. Almost guarantee that the app Bortie created will soon be sunsetted, so this is good time to think about re-platforming. Will ask also about what statistics can be pulled and by whom
 - Is there anything in BB module that might do this; or is new HR platform helpful
 - Killgore: Will ask Ruth Newbury/BB
 - Tessier: Possibly Workday for HR, but think it's a bad idea for students
 - Hart: in favor platforming to BB to possibly increase student uptake; AND so departments may be able to add extra questions
 - Killgore: We need to find out if using BB would allow departments to add questions specific to them/their courses
 - [?] Email from 2020 from Rachel Nichols that they had added a question:
 MATH wanted it. ERC voted to allow it but it never actually happened because of Covid
 - Availability: SRIs available only in spring/fall; otherwise unfair to some faculty and contractually, for tenured faculty, SRIs only required one semester
