

NEAS Standard Eight Meeting Notes

November 16, 2011

The PowerPoint presentation was reviewed and amended.

Slide One was decided to focus in on space planning and the regularity with which the college evaluates, modifies, repairs, plans and develops new learning spaces. The learning spaces committee plays a key role in this process.

Slide Two rates the progress to date of this activity and though the rating of C was probably realistic the experiences with the CollegeNet family of products (R25, S25, and X25) were noted as leading CCRI in the right direction concerning description of classes, assignment of sections and times and describing how campus space was being utilized.

Slide Three speaks specifically about continuing improvements in the network infrastructure, redundancy and business continuity, virtual desktops and business analytics and reporting.

Slide Four focuses on the expected expanding requirement of multimedia streaming, “green” initiatives, creation of the Flanagan campus data center and increasing attention to cloud services that supplement those applications offered on campus.

The bullets on each campus describe those responses to the Year Five review that both Physical Plant and IT have undertaken.
