To Enroll at CCRI

An Application for Enrollment at CCRI: <http://www.ccri.edu/oes/admissions/learnhowtoapply.html> must be submitted prior to completing the Performance-Based Health Science Application. Note: If you have an admission application on file, an additional application is not necessary. On the CCRI Application for Enrollment, you should apply to General Studies as your first choice than select your health science program concentration. Once you complete the username lookup, it will take 30 minutes for your account to be processed. If you are currently enrolled in a degree or certificate program and/or have earned credits at a college you previously attended, please submit an official college transcript from that college to the Flanagan Campus at 1762 Louisquisset Pike, Lincoln, RI 02865. Students transferring credits to meet PBHS program requirements must plan ahead, as the transfer process can take between two and three weeks to complete. Admission Notifications

You will be notified about **conditional acceptance** through your **MyCCRI email account**. The conditional acceptance email will include information about a mandatory background check that must be completed within the specified timeframe. (Note: Nursing has an additional procedure for compliance of health records requirements). If this is not completed on time, your application will no longer be considered for acceptance within this application period. Any applicants not admitted and still interested in the program, must reapply during the next open PBHS application period.
