

## FAFSA Workshop Appointment Checklist

- Dependent students, at least one parent needs to create an FSA ID
- o Parent and student must use different email addresses and phone numbers
- o For students, use personal email, not a school email address

Student's Federal Income Tax Return (including schedules)
Student's W2's, 1099's or form Schedule C
Parent's Federal Income Tax Return (including schedules)
Parent's W2's, 1099's or form Schedule C
Parent's social security number, date of birth, marital status and date.
Dependent students only)
Amounts of any additional income received such as child support, social security,
welfare benefits, etc.
Eligible non-citizens – permanent resident card

\*The **2023-2024** FAFSA requires 2021 income information. Valid for the Fall 2023, Spring 2024, and Summer 2024 Term.

- \*The **2024-2025** FAFSA requires 2022 income information. Valid for the Fall 2024, Spring 2025, and Summer 2025 Term.
