



## Technology Grant Application

**Summary of program:** The CCRI Technology Grant helps students who have experienced financial hardship due to the disruption of campus operations that is creating a barrier to continued college enrollment and completion. The Technology Grant helps with expenses such as laptops, internet access and other unforeseen costs related to remote learning. Funds are limited in availability, and eligible students will be reviewed on a rolling, first-come, first-awarded basis. Students are generally only considered for one Technology Grant.

**To be considered, a student must:**

- Be currently enrolled in a degree or certificate program at CCRI
- Have completed the 2021-2022 FAFSA
- \*Note: Funding may be available for students who are ineligible for federal financial aid or unable to file a FAFSA, but demonstrate financial or an emergency need.

**Please note, the Technology Fund is not structured for payment of CCRI tuition and fees, nor is available to upgrade fully functioning technology. It is emergency assistance when no other solutions are available.**

**If approved for a grant for other Technology needs, your grant will be refunded by the Bursar’s Office. If you have not already signed up for e-refunds, <https://www.ccri.edu/bursar/e-refund.html> please do so to allow the grant to be direct deposited in your bank account. Otherwise, you will be mailed a check, these are processed weekly.**
