About the Online RN to BSN Degree Completion Option

- Complete your degree in as few as three semesters
- No traditional on-site clinical requirements; clinical applications are interwoven throughout the curriculum
- RN-BSN Option consists of seven nursing courses and seven liberal arts and sciences courses (47 credit hours)
- Associate of Science in Nursing graduates with an active RN license can receive up to of 82 proficiency credits. The BSN Degree program requires 129 credit hours, with a minimum of 32 credits completed at Chamberlain College of Nursing in order to graduate.
