Senate Meeting Agenda

Each spring semester, the Vice-President of Academic Affairs shall convene a Meeting

Scheduling Committee to create a master meeting schedule for the upcoming academic year. The

committee shall consist of four Senators, one from each division, representatives from Marketing,

4 Academic Affairs, the President's Office, Student Affairs, the Registrar's office, and others as needed.

5 The purpose of the committee's work shall be to minimize conflicts between college wide meetings and

6 meetings which involve faculty.

The Meeting Scheduling Committee shall develop a broad calendar of meetings on Fridays

throughout the academic year across two time blocks, one in the morning (8 a.m. to 12 p.m.) and one in

the afternoon (12 p.m. - 4 p.m.). Events which are scheduled on days other than Friday shall also be

included. The schedule shall be posted on the college website by June 1st. Meetings and events

scheduled after this date shall avoid overlapping with the established schedule.

The Meeting Scheduling Committee calendar will include Senate meetings, Senate sub-

committee meetings, Curriculum Committee meetings, General Faculty meetings, and any other

committee meetings and events involving faculty. Department chairs will notify the committee of their
