What is the course schedule?

How long is the course?

Level courses are 50 hours (3 months). Conversation classes are 20 hours (2 months).

How much is the course fee?

Level courses are \$235 to register + \$40-\$60 required textbook depending on the level. Conversation classes are \$115 to register.
