Here are the correct answers for the MLA documentation quiz:

1. e Both a and d are correct.
2. e Both a and c are correct.
3. a “I’m stealing food from my hungry neighbors, so I’m a really bad person” (Smith, qtd. in Petit 1).
4. d Many people, in addition to the thieves, are injured by theft (Petit 1).
5. b Theft of a tomato will result in the thief frowning, rather than smiling like the gardener (Petit 1).
6. c If three or more authors have written an article or a book together, the first author’s name is needed, followed by “et al.” and the page number.
7. c An organization’s name or a title should be included in the parenthesis or the lead-in phrase.
8. c If the source is a PDF file that is an exact copy of an original paper version, then the page number should be included after the author’s last name.
9. a Author. Title of source. Title of container(s), information about each container (such as other contributors, version, number, publisher, date, and web address). Date of access.
